Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at the Williamsburg Settlement Clubhouse, 1602 Hoyt Lane, Katy, Texas 77449, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 27, 2011, at 6:30 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be as follows:

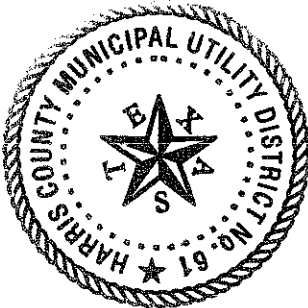
1. Consider comments from members of the public;
2. Review and consider approval of minutes of the August 23, 2011, Board of Director's meeting;
3. Consider financial and investment reports, including invoices presented, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Consider adoption of operating budget for fiscal year ending October 31, 2012;
5. Consider approval of Unclaimed Property Report as of June 30, 2008, and authorize filing of same with State Comptroller prior to November 1, 2011;
6. Consider engagement of auditor to prepare the District's audit reports for the fiscal year ending October 31, 2011, and October 31, 2012, and the taking of any action required in connection therewith;
7. Consider report on the status of collection of taxes, the status of collection of delinquent tax accounts, the payment of invoices, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
8. Receive Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning establishment of the District's 2011 tax rate, consider proposal of District's 2011 tax rate and authorize publication of notice of public hearing relative to setting District tax rate, and the taking of such other actions as may be required in connection therewith;
9.
 - a) Consider authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts for construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including:
 - (i) authorize preparation of plans and specifications for rehabilitation of sanitary sewer system;
 - b) Consider status of construction contracts and the approval of any change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith, including:
 - (i) contract with Monarch Civil Constructors for extension of District facilities to serve the StoneArch development; and
 - c) Consider acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
10. Consider status of Bond Application Report relative to the District's proposed \$2,970,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2011, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
11. Consider requests for issuance of utility commitments and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
12. Consider report on regional sewage treatment plant, including compliance with wastewater discharge permit, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
13. Consider report regarding the status of development of property within the District;

14. Consider approval of Mutual Service Agreement relative to TC Houston Industrial Development, Inc. project;
15. Consider report on District's water, sanitary sewer and storm sewer systems, including:
 - (i) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - (ii) Review of monthly service billings and collections;
 - (iii) Compliance with water well permit;
 - (iv) Appeals of District charges; and
 - (v) Status of storage tank;and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;

Consider report on meeting with representatives of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 62 and operators to develop policies and procedures for maintaining high water accountability in connection with opening the two distribution systems, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
17. Consider status of meter replacement throughout the District, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
18. Consider surface water issues and the West Harris County Regional Water Authority, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
19. Consider discussion relative to training procedures for fire department, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
20. Consider discussion regarding items to be placed in quarterly District newsletter; and
21. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.
